

## **UCLA Tenured Faculty Position in Cardiology**

The **Division of Cardiology** in the **Department of Medicine** at the **David Geffen School of Medicine at UCLA** invites applications for a tenured faculty position as a clinician-investigator at the level of Associate or Full Professor. The position involves a majority of time dedicated to basic research in the field of protein trafficking and its applications to heart failure and cardiac arrhythmias, combined with a clinical interest in advanced heart failure. The candidate should be an MD-PhD or be an MD with equivalent level training in a basic research field, an established track record of productive extramurally-funded research, and be board-certified in Internal Medicine and Cardiovascular Diseases. Training/experience in management of advanced heart failure, including heart transplantation and mechanical circulatory support, is highly desirable. The successful candidate will become a member of the interdisciplinary UCLA Cardiovascular Research Laboratory and will be encouraged to develop translational research in collaboration with the Advanced Heart Failure Section in the Division of Cardiology, as well as participate in the teaching of research and clinical trainees.
